

EHMS After School Program 2019-2020 Behavior Policy

By registering for any After School Program at EHMS, students agree to adhere to all EHMS and district policies.

Laptops

Students may use laptops in the library only, not in the gym or the lunch room/ garage. Students may only use the laptop for school-appropriate usage.

Cell Phones

Students need to keep their cell phones in their backpacks during the After School Program. If a student needs to communicate with a parent, they need to alert staff. At the first offense, the phone must be turned over to staff and will be returned at the end of the day. After three offenses, the phone must be turned over to staff, and the student may retrieve the phone from the office the next day.

Snacks

Snacks are available in the lunchroom to all students staying after school. Snacks are available from 3:40 pm to 3:50 pm and must be consumed in the lunch room, unless permission to eat it elsewhere is given by the staff person of the program the student is attending. Students are expected to clean up after themselves and put all trash and recycling into the appropriate receptacles.

Hall Conduct and Hall Passes

Students need to be at their designated activity no later than 3:55 pm. While in the hallways, students are expected to be courteous to others. The following are not allowed: locker slamming, public displays of affection, running, hitting, forming groups to block the hall, pushing, playing rough, and sliding down the banisters. Students who attend TAS and need to get something from their locker will need a hall pass signed by a teacher.

Activity Bus

All bus eligible students may ride the activity bus home. However, riding the activity bus is a privilege, not a right, and proper behavior is expected.

3 Strike Policy

Note: Any strike given during the program, while loading the buses, or on the bus, counts toward the three strikes. Strikes may be given by any teacher, After School Program staff, or bus driver involved in the program.

- Strike 1: verbal warning
- Strike 2: self-reflection sheet or staff/bus driver option
- Strike 3: Student may not attend the after school program for 1 day.
- Flagrant Foul: A flagrant foul is defined as extreme misbehavior and is treated as if it were a 3rd strike.
- Second occurrence of Strike 3: Student may not attend the After School Program for 1 week.
- Third occurrence of Strike 3: Student may not attend the After School Program for 2 weeks.
- Fourth occurrence of Strike 3: Student may not attend the After School Program for 3 weeks.

For behavior tracking purposes, all After School Program staff, including club staff, enrichment activity leaders, etc and transportation need to inform the After School Coordinator any time a 3rd strike is issued. The After School Coordinator will inform the Assistant Principal, who will contact the student's parents.
